Jazz 91.9 WCLK is a National Public Radio (NPR) affiliate station licensed to Clark Atlanta University. Jazz 91.9 WCLK is dedicated to developing and providing high quality multimedia and broadcast programs that uplift, educate and inform the Atlanta community and worldwide audience on <a href="WCLK.com">WCLK.com</a>. Jazz 91.9 is dedicated to increasing the awareness of the significance of Jazz music as an American art form and, guiding and training students in all aspects of broadcast and public media services.

Jazz 91.9 WCLK vision is to leverage the WCLK legacy as a Jazz and cultural icon both locally and globally. Jazz 91.9 WCLK will cultivate the resources that ensure uninterrupted quality broadcast and public media services, through the adoption and implementation of new technologies and content delivery platforms that serve the widest audience possible.

On April 10, 1974, Jazz 91.9 WCLK aired its first Jazz selection, "Maiden Voyage," by Herbie Hancock. Under the direction of former Clark College President, Vivian Henderson, and former Director of Mass Communications, Charles Hobson, WCLK became the first Black federally licensed educational FM station in Georgia. Transmitting from Clark College's McPhetters - Dennis Hall at a mere 54 watts from Noon until midnight, WCLK marked the beginning of an exciting journey to cultivate an Atlanta public radio entity that would educate, inform and entertain listeners.
