Because of social distancing due to the COVID-19 health pandemic, you may have noticed that our membership campaigns are without **volunteers** and as a result without **food donors.**

Election Day is Tuesday, **November 3, 2020**. Voter registration deadlines vary per state. [Click here](#) to find out deadlines in your state. Individuals must be 18 years old and a United States citizen to be eligible to vote anywhere in the US. Items needed to register to vote: 1) identifying number associated with a driver's license or nondriver identification card; 2) or, the last four digits of Social Security number.

Georgia allows any voter to request a ballot by mail. Individuals can also vote in person. Georgia offers early voting. According to Business Insider, 39 states allow their residents to easily register to vote online with proof of residency. In the others states, individuals must register by mail or in-person. Twenty-one states and the District of Columbia currently allow voters to register to vote on Election Day with valid proof of residency if they miss the deadline to register by mail or online. 


MORTGAGE MINUTE

THE BASICS YOU SHOULD KNOW!

WHEN QUALIFYING FOR A LOAN, WHAT DO LENDERS LOOK AT IN REGARDS TO INCOME?

Generally Lenders will need the past 2 years tax returns for self-employed and W2 wage earners. They will average the income for the past 2 years. If income is declining they will use the lower amount. If you received an increase in pay due to a promotion they may be able to use the new amount. Part-time or second jobs must also have a 2 year history to be used. Temporary disability, workers compensation or any income that will not continue for a minimum of three years cannot be used.
